EVENT SCHEDULE:

Sat, May 16, 2026	
7:05am	Gym ready for team warm-up. Complex opens to public at 7am. Suit up in the holding area outside both gyms. Vehicles parked illegally will be ticketed & towed without warning by the complex.
7:15am	CAPTAINS: Unless you receive an email from us prior (the week of the tourney), FULL TEAM checks in with their respective Draw Coordinator. Reffing teams initiate coin toss, 5 minute on-court warm-up followed by 2 minute hitting. Reffing team MUST have 4 personnel every match.
7:30am	First round robin match. All round robin matches are 0 – 25, 0- 25, all cap.
7:00pm	Start of last round robin match. We must complete all round robin matches on May 16 th to ensure double knockout, (two) tiered play-offs begin at 7:15am on May 17 th . EVERYONE must vacate the gym no later than 7:45pm.
Sun, May 17, 2026	
7:05am	Gym ready for team warm-up. Complex opens to public at 7am. Suit up in the holding area outside both gyms. Vehicles parked illegally will be ticketed & towed without warning by the complex.
7:15am	Reffing teams initiate coin toss, 5 minute on-court warm-up followed by 2 minute hitting. Reffing team MUST have 4 personnel every match. TIME DEFAULT RULE SHALL APPLY. ONE POINT FOR EVERY MINUTE YOU ARE LATE IN STARTING. You must have 5 players ON THE COURT to start a match & the ghost server rule shall apply. A player must be on the roster sheet & have played a complete set on Saturday to be eligible for the Sunday double knockout, (two) tiered play-offs. Front door: 0 – 21, 0- 21, 0 – 15, all cap. Back door: 0 – 25, cap. Possibly 0 – 31, cap if all teams take to the courts in a timely fashion. In order for me to facilitate double knockout, tiered play-offs I require your cooperation to start play before 7:30am on Sat, May 16 th & before 7:30am on Sun, May 17 th . The championship game is one match best 2 out of 3 sets. Depending on remaining time, caps could be removed. The winner on the back door side does not have to win two matches to be crowned champion.
5:45pm	EVERYONE must vacate the gym no later than 5:45pm. Please, ensure you take your belongings & garbage with you. Place refundables in the appropriate containers. We will be donating all found items left in the gym to Bonsor Lost & Found. Contact their Front Desk for your missing item(s).

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Team Uniforms:

Jerseys mandatory. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WILL MONITOR & DEDUCT RE: PERFORMANCE BOND. Basketball jerseys will no longer be acceptable unless they meet ALL color AND # requirements (provide an email picture before the April 1, 2026 deadline if you are unsure).

In the minimum, 8 inch number on the centre back **and** 4 inch number on front chest over the heart. Team shorts must be consistent and contrasting in colour. Liberties: Sleeve length, but shirts must match. Shirts under uniform.

Food & Drink:

ONLY WATER & CAPPED SPORTS DRINKS PERMITTED IN THE GYM

Captains shall ensure teammates and spectators adhere to this facility rule.

You take lunch OUTSIDE the gym in the common area when you are not playing.

Please inform the Tournament Director or Committee Member if your team leaves the gym area. Captains, ensure you supply the Tournament Director with contact telephone numbers, addresses, & emails of **all** your teammates.

Cancellation Refund Schedule:

- February 1, 2026 - 80% refunded
- March 1, 2026 - 70% refunded
- April 1, 2026 - 60% refunded (**upon finding a replacement team**)
- May 1, 2026 - 50% refunded (**upon finding a replacement team**)

Libero Defined (section 19.3.2.1 of FIVB 2009 - 2012):

The Libero is restricted to perform as a back row player and is not allowed to complete an attack from anywhere if at the moment of contact the ball is entirely above the top of the net. A teammate may not complete an attack hit, when, at the moment of attack hit, the ball is entirely above the top of the net, if the ball is coming from an overhead finger pass by a Libero in the front zone. The ball may be freely attacked if the Libero makes the same action from behind the front zone.

The Libero is allowed to replace any player in the back row position. Replacements involving the Libero are not counted as regular substitutions. They are unlimited, but there must be a rally between two Libero replacements. The Libero can only be replaced by the player they replace. **Maximum of 12 substitutions per game.**

The Libero may not block or attempt to block.

The Libero can not serve.

The Libero must wear a different color/design top in contrast to other members of the team.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WILL MONITOR & DEDUCT RE: PERFORMANCE BOND. We will be permitting 2 Liberos on the court per NCAA rules because a lot of teams travel from the USA.

Who is of Asian Descent?

The definition of "Asian" may be inclusive and broad, and applies to people who come from or whose ancestors come from: (not a complete list). **To participate in this tournament one must be at least 25% Asia:**

- East Asia - China, Hong Kong S.A.R., Japan, Mongolia, Korea, Taiwan.
- South Asia - Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka.
- Central Asia - Iran/Persia, Afghanistan, Kazakhstan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan.
- Southeast Asia - Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam, Burma.

***** Import Situation: *****

A team may have 2 non-Asian members on their roster, but **only one of them may be on the court at a time.**

Please, remember the United Nations & the Senate of Canada passed a motion in December 2001 designating May as Asian Heritage month (celebration of ethnicity, culture, arts & sport) & this annual 2 day volleyball tournament is in compliance with all international, Canadian & British Columbia human rights legislations.

FOR THE MAY 2026 ASIAN M/W6's OPEN:

***** \$150 PERFORMANCE BOND *****

Tournament: If a team is not present at the tournament they registered in, they will lose their entry fee and performance bond.

Officiating: If a team is late or does not perform their officiating tasks, they will lose their performance bond. A portion of the performance bond will go to the team or teams who did the officiating. This rule applies to round robin & play-off matches.

Uniform: If a team does not wear the required uniforms on both tournament days, they will lose their performance bond.

Registration: If a non-registered player (not on the official roster) participates in the tournament, the team will lose their performance bond.

Alcohol: By registering for this 2 day tournament you hereby agree to not bring &/or consume alcoholic beverages in the Bonsor Recreation Complex nor its parking facilities.

Garbage: You will forfeit the team performance bond if any garbage is left behind in the gym.

Your \$150 Performance Bond shall be returned to the Captain / Registrant within a week

after the end of the tournament provided all criteria have been met.
